Filming in Berlin

TV teams planning to film in Berlin will find some basic information below.

Berlin is a popular backdrop – for video clips, films, TV series, advertising and other formats. Even small journalistic film and photo teams, that carry out photo or film work on public streets in Berlin and Brandenburg, require a filming permit. Filming permits are provided by the relevant [district offices](#) and must be requested there.

The filming permit can be requested with this [document](#).

Public streets and places include the following:

- Brandenburg Gate
- Reichstag (**only** external recordings are permitted here)
- Berlin Wall
- Gendarmenmarkt
- Alexanderplatz

Prior filming permits must also be obtained for all indoor filming or for filming on private property.
