Berlin, 9 October 2017 From the 10 to 12 October, Berlin is presenting itself to American Congress customers and event planners with its own new booth (Booth B2623) at IMEX America in Las Vegas. This year, the digital conference **TechCrunch Disrupt 2017** is moving from London to Berlin (4–5 Dec, Arena Berlin, techcrunch.com). The **re:publica** has been held annually in Berlin for ten years. The **Q Berlin Questions** is a new conference format from *visitBerlin*. International speakers discuss the most important issues in the areas of work, governance, cultural identity, social justice, and urbanisation (19–20 Oct., Schiller Theater, q.berlin; participation and tickets via q.berlin/q-marathon). At IMEX America, which is one of the most important marketing platforms for customers from North and South America, the *visitBerlin* Berlin Convention Office is promoting further events in the areas of IT and digital economy. They represented 13% of the meetings held in the first half of 2017.

At IMEX America, the focus will also be on *visitBerlin* Berlin Convention Office's new service: The Berlin Speakers Pool helps organizers to find suitable high-calibre speakers, local experts, or moderators for their program.
