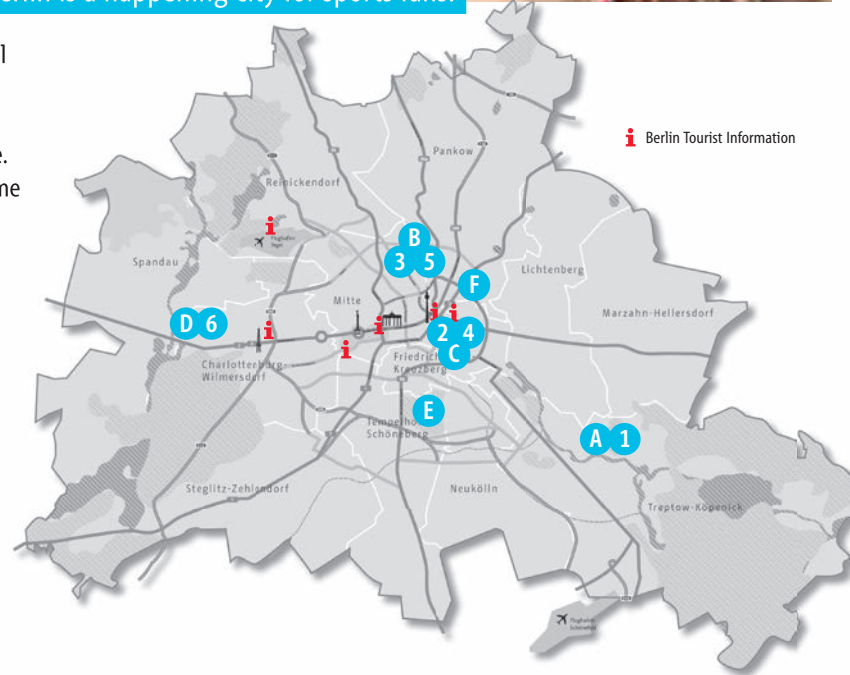

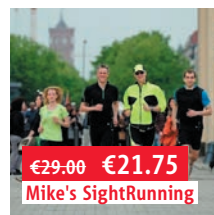
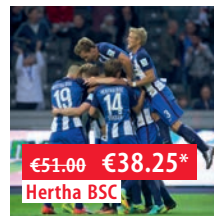

DFB Cup Final

International German Gymnastics Festival

FIA Formula E Championship

18 June

Velothon Berlin

2 July

3rd Berlin Flussbad Cup
