Berlin, 21 March 2014 Berlin will host "Evidence", Chinese artist Ai Weiwei's largest solo exhibition ever, from 3 April. The concept artist has created an installation especially for Berlin's Martin-Gropius-Bau that will play off the building's large atrium. The Ai Weiwei show will be complemented with "The 8 of Paths: Art in Beijing" in the Uferhallen from 29 April. Other cultural highlights in 2014 include an exhibition of works by sculptor Rembrandt Bugatti in the Alte Nationalgalerie from 28 March and the open-air exhibition "Paradiesapfel" ("Apple of Paradise") at Potsdam's Park Sanssouci from 18 April. Style icon David Bowie will be honoured from 20 May at the Martin-Gropius-Bau. The Neue Nationalgalerie will remember the artistic upheaval of the 1960s with an exhibition of works by Otto Piene, opening 18 July.
