It will be sold at Berlin Tourist Information centres, at berlin-welcomecard.com, at turbopass.com, and by many travel organisers. The *Berlin WelcomeCard all inclusive* is being offered in partnership with Turbopass.

In addition to the *Berlin WelcomeCard all inclusive*, the *Berlin WelcomeCard* is also available. For as little as €19.90, the *Berlin WelcomeCard* offers unlimited travel on Berlin public transport and discounts of up to 50 per cent at more than 200 tourist and cultural attractions across the city.
