The Berlin WelcomeCard has been issued by *visitBerlin* since 1994.

| Good to know

- **Before starting your travels:** The Berlin WelcomeCard must be validated by stamping it in a public transport validating machine before its first use and should be presented to the discount partner before using their service or placing your order.
Children: Any number of children up to 6 years of age are included in all versions of the Berlin WelcomeCard. Up to three children between the ages of 6 and 14 are able to accompany an adult at no extra charge on all AB and ABC tickets of the Berlin WelcomeCard. Luggage, prams, and up to 1 dog can also generally accompany you for free as well.
- **Schönefeld Airport** and the city of **Potsdam** are in **fare zone C**. Visitors arriving at Schönefeld Airport and those who wish to visit Potsdam should purchase the Berlin WelcomeCard ABC. A Zone C add-on ticket cannot be combined with the Berlin WelcomeCard AB. Zones A and B cover the entire city limits of Berlin.
